ENTREPRENEURSHIP SUPPORT FUNDS			
Access	Receive annual allocation in Entrepreneurship Support Fund, which may be used to support entrepreneurship-related activities after affirming previously distributed "marketing funds" are depleted. Submit check request, providing details in advance instead of annual activity report.		
Amount	Up to \$1,000	Up to \$2,000	Up to \$3,000

E-Community Marketing Materials	May use logo, listed on website, access to templates and best practices, free promotion on E-Community social media accounts, etc.		
E-Community Resources	On E-Community e-mail list, receive tips and best practices, including exclusive content created for and shared only with E-Community Partners. Receive E-Community handbook, program resources and marketing materials, loan portfolio statistics booklet, and other resources.		
NetWork Kansas Support	Referral Center available, limited support from E-Community staff.	Field manager is primary point of contact, supports a relationship via phone, e-mail, and in-person meetings.	
Tax Credits	NetWork Kansas manages tax credit donations.
